

School Uniform

The wearing of the College uniform is compulsory for all Year 7 to 12 students. Decisions regarding school uniform are made by School Council and we ask all parents and students for their support in following policy.

If a student has difficulty purchasing the College uniform, they should contact the Assistant Principal or Sub-School Leader. If a student cannot wear the uniform they should bring a note from home and give it to their teacher during first session. The teacher will issue an 'Out of Uniform Pass'. If a student is out of uniform without an acceptable note, they will receive a warning on the first occasion. A further incident will receive a detention.

Year 12 students are permitted to wear a school student-designed rugby top as part of their uniform.

Please note the change in footwear policy commencing in 2013—all students are to wear black school shoes.

THE COLLEGE UNIFORM

OPTIONAL ITEMS: College blazer/jacket (jackets can be ordered at Andrews Land & Surf, Orbost), a navy school tie with the school emblem or a navy scarf.

Local school uniform suppliers include D G Clothing & Footwear and Andrew's Land & Surf.

Secondhand uniforms are available through the Canteen Manager.

FOOTWEAR (see uniform)

Australian Standards require that substantial (non-slip, closed-in) footwear shall be worn at all times. Students will be excluded from an activity or class if the teacher believes there is a safety issue.

JEWELLERY

The wearing of earrings is not encouraged; however, a maximum of two studs or sleepers per ear is tolerated. The College accepts no responsibility for the loss or theft of jewellery. With this in mind, students are not encouraged to wear other jewellery to school.

BAND & CHOIR UNIFORM

Members of the College Band or Choir are required to wear the following uniform when they perform:

Black pants or skirt and a black belt

Lemon long-sleeved shirt (available from Andrews Land & Surf)

Black shoes and socks or stockings

Swing Band - black shirt (supplied)

Senior Band - maroon shirt

SPORT/PHYSICAL EDUCATION UNIFORM

There is no official uniform; however, students are required to change into appropriate clothing for the activity: for example, t-shirt, shorts or tracksuit pants **and sneakers**. In observance of our SunSmart Policy (p 17) **no singlets are to be worn for outdoor activities**.

The sport/PE uniform is currently under review with a student-driven request for a uniform.
