

Expectations of students in Webex classes

Our Webex classes are designed to support the learning of students during this period of Remote and Flexible Learning. We expect that our school purpose and values will always be clearly visible, including during this period.

In recent years, students and staff developed a document titled Our Values in Action, which outlines the expected behaviours that demonstrate **Respect, Aspiration, Belonging and Resilience** in the following areas:

- In class
- Outside class
- In 'cyberspace' and using technology
- In the public eye

What we expect:	What this means in Webex classes:	How teachers may respond:
<p>We expect to see the same behaviours in classes held during Remote and Flexible Learning that we expect to see in classes held on-site. It is possible that Webex sessions could also be seen and heard by others in a house. This means they fit into the area of 'In the Public Eye' as well as 'In Class.' In line with 'Our Values in Action,' we expect:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. We are on time 2. We listen when others are speaking 3. We have a positive impact on others' learning 4. We are polite 5. We help others 	<p>In our Webex classes this means:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - We are logged in at the start of the lesson - Our microphones remain on mute unless we are asked to speak - We stay focused and allow others to remain focused on listening to the teacher - We use the chat box function for questions and comments that are relevant to the lesson 	<p>When students are not following the expected behaviours listed above, teachers will decide about the appropriate course of action. Depending on the situation, teachers may:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Keep teaching and deal with the individuals later - Provide the student with a verbal warning - Make a note on Compass for Sub School Coordinators to follow up with - Mute the students' microphone - Make direct contact with student and/or parents - Remove students from the Webex session or future Webex sessions
